How you can help



Whenever travelling across the border into Saskatchewan:

-  Inspect boat equipment and remove mussels, vegetation and scrape off any grainy surfaces
-  Drain all water from engine cooling systems, bilges, live wells, bait containers and ballast tank systems
-  Wash all equipment, including trailers and hitches, with high pressure and / or hot soapy water
-  Dry equipment before relaunching and allow at least 5 days drying in the sun

These basic cleaning steps apply to any and all Watercraft
